Why Foundational Learning Competency?

- Foundational Learning Competence (FLC) is designed to enable the learner to access further qualifications, be more efficient and able to work and engage better in reallife situations by establishing a proper Foundational in their abilities to communicate efficiently and calculate, think critically, and solve problems in their everyday life, both at work and at home.
- FLC course duration is 4 months, consisting of two subjects, maths literacy and communication.
- Learners have a workbook to be completed during course, formative and summative assessments.
- At the end of the course an external exam takes place under IEB, Statement of results are issued under IEB.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Statement of Results in English and Mathematical Literacy for AET level 3
- Independent Education Board readiness assessment declaring the learner competent to start FLC

- Entry to Occupational Certificate trades under QCTO

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
