

WHY ECD PRACTITIONER?

- The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a student to operate as an Early Childhood Development Practitioner.
- An Early Childhood Development Practitioner plans and prepares early childhood activities, facilitates, and mediates learning.
- Observes and assesses the progress of children. Reflects on learning in an inclusive, playbased environment to support the holistic development of children. (From conception – school going) in different centre-based or non-centre-based settings.
- The course duration is 12 months including theory, practical and workplace experience components. Sediba gives the opportunity to its students to complete the practical as well as the workplace experience on site at Sediba Academy. Learner will complete a Portfolio of Evidence consisting of formative, summative assessments, and will write an External Assessment under ETDP Seta, Certificate is issued by QCTO.
